This color class focuses on aspects of the element of design COLOR, which provides various ways for artists to utilize color more effectively in a variety of media. Because a study of color can be hampered by the students' struggle with mixing pigment, this class will use Color Aid papers, which provide an immediacy of color consistency, and allow the student to focus on creating a problem solution for each color effect or interaction.
